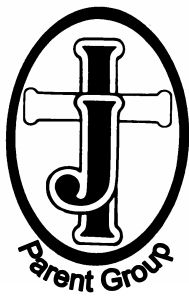

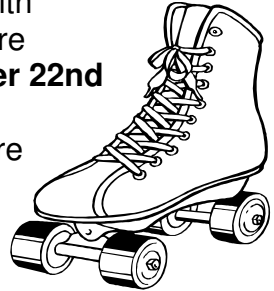

GIFT ROOM

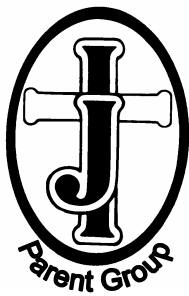
