OLYMPIC DAY



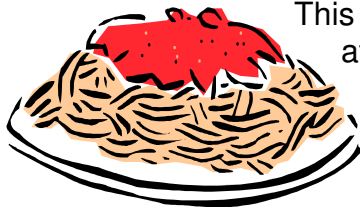

- *Apply sunscreen prior to the event.

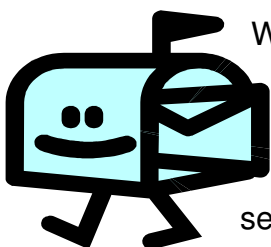

SPAGHETTI SOCIAL

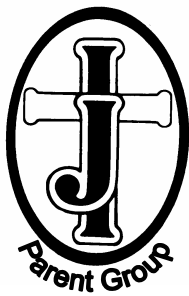
