What gifts has God blessed you with; sports, brains, talent? Don't forget to write a card or note to your children and share how blessed you feel to have them.

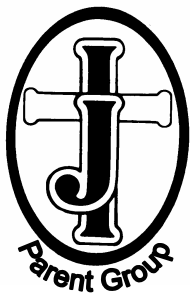
