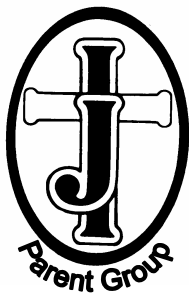
**The Incredible Vacuum of Space show:**

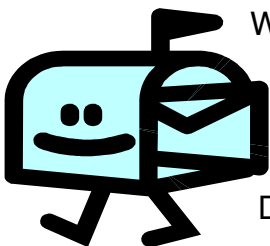
### IMPORTANT OLYMPIC DAY INFORMATION

\*For safety reasons, students must arrive at Rivier College **no earlier than 8:30am**.

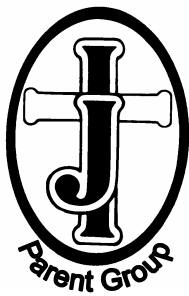
\*Return the enclosed Yellow Health form **only** if your child will be bringing medication to Olympic Day (such as an inhaler, epipen, etc...).

### WEE DELIVER

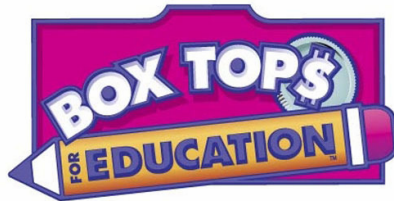
